## **NEWS FROM LAMBDA STATE:**

I attended my first Lambda State Executive Board meeting on Sept 21 and 22, and learned a lot! Here is some of the important information shared at that meeting:

- ❖ **The name of our society- Delta Kappa Gamma will remain the same. No changes at this time.**
- ❖ **We will no longer be called Lambda State. All state societies will be referred to by the state name. We are now called Lambda State Illinois**

- ❖ **Communications and Publicity has been changed to Communications and Marketing**
- ❖ **New members are no longer “initiated” but “inducted”**
- ❖ **DKG is now accepting collegiate women-juniors and seniors in college studying to be teachers-for membership. These college women will pay only \$20 dues to International.**
- ❖ **DKG will accept any woman as a member who is a paid educator. This opens the door to religious educators, trade schools, businesses, etc.**
- ❖ **Non-members(but potential new members) can attend our state convention**
- ❖ **Each chapter must create their budget by spring, since dues will now be due by June 30<sup>th</sup>, as of 2019.**
- ❖ **Each chapter will send their own international dues directly to international**
- ❖ **A special training will be given to chapter treasurers in February 2019. Detailed information about this will be sent to chapter presidents and treasurers. Chapter treasurers are also encouraged to attend convention in 2019 for further training.**
