The Delta Kappa Gamma Society International is an organization with the purpose of honoring women educators seeking to advance professionalism in education. Gamma Gamma, a local chapter, offers two \$2,000 non-renewable recruitment grants. One grant is in memory of member, Anne Fussell; the second grant is offered by our local Gamma Gamma Chapter. Only District 211 female, senior students pursuing a career in education will be selected and awarded either one of these grants. A Gamma Gamma mentor will be provided for each recipient.

Criteria for evaluating each applicant is as follows:

1. Interest in a career in education
2. Academic standing
3. Involvement in school and out of school activities

The following packet of documents must be electronically filed to the email address below, and received on or before MONDAY, APRIL 11, 2022 (firm deadline). The recruitment grant will be presented on the evening of Thursday, May 5, 2022.

1. Completed typed application.
2. An official transcript-showing your high school credits, grades, class rank, and ACT or SAT score.
3. Two letters of reference from a teacher, counselor, or personal reference. Letters of recommendation should include the relationship to applicant, and any opinions and/or observations of qualities that would benefit the applicant as an educator.

Only complete applications will be reviewed. All supporting documentation must be included with the application. Absolutely no materials will be accepted after the electronic filing date indicated above. Scholarship applications will be kept for seven (7) years after which time all materials will be destroyed.

Applicants will be contacted electronically once their completed packet of documents is received, as well as after the selection committee has made a decision. (Winning applicants will also receive a phone call instructing them about the grant presentation dinner.)

*Or, what talents or strengths you have as a future educator.

NOTE: Essay will be evaluated on the quality and clarity of the response; along with use of conventions. Essay should be no longer than 2 pages in length.

2. HONORS AND ACTIVITIES: Please list or write short answers giving examples of academic awards, membership in organizations, leadership positions, community service positions or volunteerism, work related honors or *any other awards you've received or activities you've participated in* beginning with the 9th grade. Make sure to include your grade levels and approximate time of involvement. These can be in school and/or out of school activities, and can also include summer participation.

3. WORK OR INTERN EXPERIENCES: Please tell about your employment experience and/ or, if you have served as an intern or mentor to children, fellow teens, or young adults during your high school years.

4. OPTIONAL: Indicate any additional information that you would like the selection committee to consider. (Examples: Any extenuating circumstances, family situations, or financial needs.)
